# California's Presidential General Election is November 3, 2020. Know your options.

## Learn

### REGISTERED VOTERS WILL RECEIVE A BALLOT IN THE MAIL.

For the November election, all voters have the option of voting by mail from the safety of their own homes. This reduces your exposure to COVID-19 while exercising your right to vote.

The Registrar of Voters is committed to providing you a safe and secure voting experience that is accessible and convenient.

You will also be able to track your mail ballot every step of the way!

You will know when it is mailed, received, and counted by the Registrar of Voters. All you need to do is sign up for **Where's My Ballot?** at [sdvote.com](http://sdvote.com).

Will there be polling places on Election Day?

**Yes.** In fact, there will be polling places open for four days, October 31 through November 3. Be prepared. There will be fewer locations than in prior elections, so your location has most likely changed. If you decide to vote in-person, you must go to your assigned location. Don't be surprised, lines may be long!



## Act

### VOTE SAFER AT HOME

We encourage you to Vote Safer at Home and we are making it easier for you to do so. Ballots will start going out in the mail the week of October 5, giving you plenty of time to mark your ballot and return it in the mail.

How to vote by mail:

**SIMPLE.** You will receive your ballot in the mail along with your "I Voted" sticker!

**SAFER.** Make voting decisions and complete your ballot comfortably, and in the safety of your own home.

**SECURE.** Seal your completed ballot in your postage paid envelope, sign it, date it and return it by mail promptly so it is received well before Election Day. You may also deposit your sealed ballot at one of many convenient drop-off locations around the county. Or, drop it off at the Registrar's office or at any polling place.



When your ballot is received, your signature on your return envelope will be compared to the signature on your voter registration to ensure they match. Your signature is required for your ballot to count! Sign your name just like it appears on your driver's license or identification card.

- FACT 1:** Over 3 million pamphlets were mailed out in the 2018 Election cycle, representing 281 tons of paper. Save paper and taxpayer dollars by receiving it electronically!
- FACT 2:** By signing up, you will be among the first voters in the county to receive it. Get a leg up on the candidates who are running and what questions are on the ballot.
- FACT 3:** No more guessing when the sample ballot and voter information pamphlet will appear in your mailbox. It'll be in your inbox!
