We are your family, friends, brothers and sisters surviving without shelter, beds, bathrooms, power, water, laundry, storage, or a warm, dry, safe place to just be.

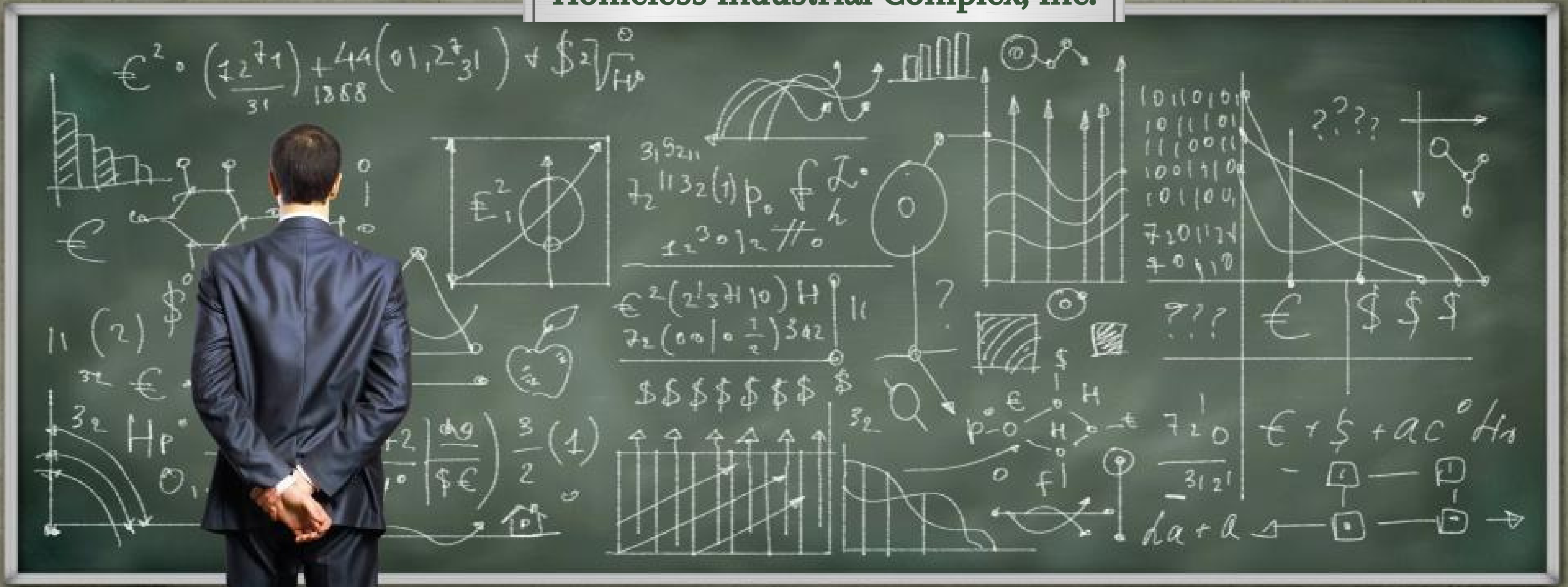
We have been rejected by society.

Step One

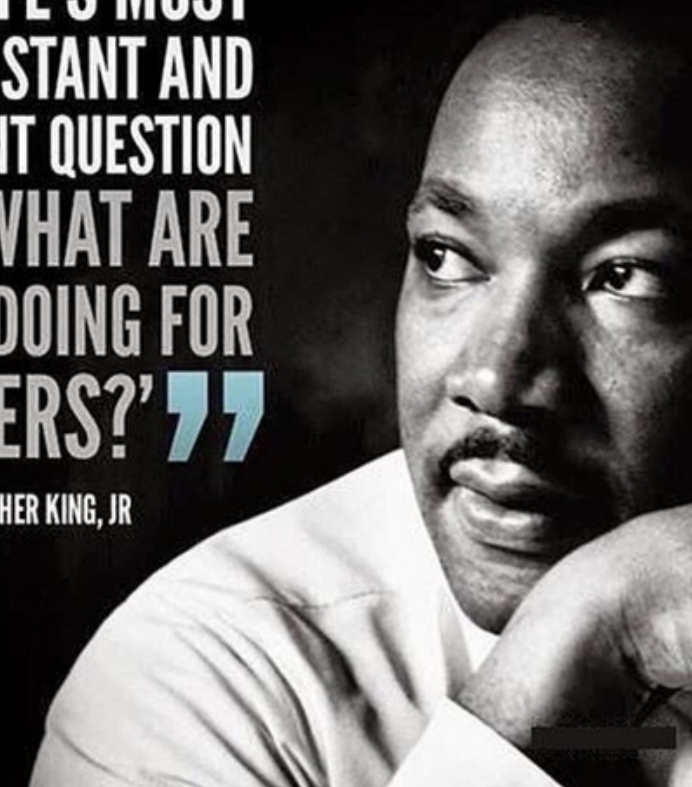
- Outdoor Neighbors.org will unite and motivate the outdoor residents in the neighborhood to do bi-weekly community service works, introducing ourselves with our efforts.

Step three

When OutdoorNeighbors.org achieves a 501c3 not-for-profit tax status, we will acquire a headquarters-- a 'members only' clubhouse to provide:

- Bathroom/shower
- Laundry facilities
- Food
- Storage
- Phone charging station
- AA/NA meetings, mental health outreach
- Legal assistance
- Day labor office
- Emergency shelter



Step four

OutdoorNeighbors will lay the groundwork to set up new communities, utilizing leadership talent among our workforce, who will teach and assist new members to establish the next Outdoor Neighbor community to keep this mission going...
